Roger and Louise Mullin Scholarship

This scholarship fund was established in 1988 by the Allentown Rotary Foundation with a significant benefactor gift from the late Roger and Louise Mullin. Roger Mullin was the former Chairman of Mack Truck and an active member of the Allentown Rotary Club.

The Allentown Rotary Club Foundation will provide three college scholarships to qualified students attending an Allentown high school - Dieruff, William Allen, Central Catholic, and Building 21. Each scholarship is for the 2024 - 2025 academic year and is an annual award of \$3,000, renewable for up to four years of college for up to \$12,000.

The scholarships will be awarded based on community service, strong leadership skills, financial need, Interact involvement (if applicable), academic achievement, and interview skills. The application process requires the submission of a completed application, along with recommendations and school transcripts, as well as participation in an interview with the scholarship committee of the Allentown Rotary Club. Applicants must be United States citizens or lawful residents, and their primary residence must be within the boundaries of the City of Allentown.

The deadline for applications for this year is February 3, 2024.
